When I get to the theater I may have to wait in line to either purchase my movie ticket at the box office or pick my ticket up at will call.



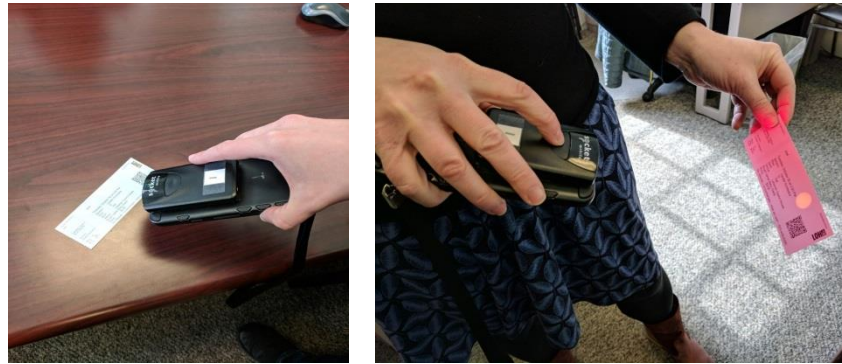

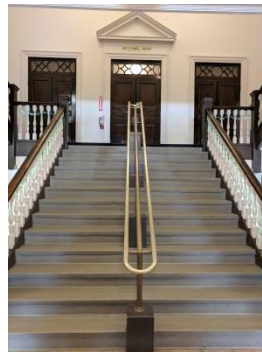
Will Call

I won't have to wait too long. While I'm waiting I can think and talk about the movie "Up" or other movies I have seen.

Once I get my ticket, I will stand in line so that the usher may scan my ticket with a special machine. The machine will flash a red light and make a beeping sound when it reads my ticket. I need to do this so that I may get in to see the movie.



After my ticket has been scanned I may go up the stairs and into the theater!

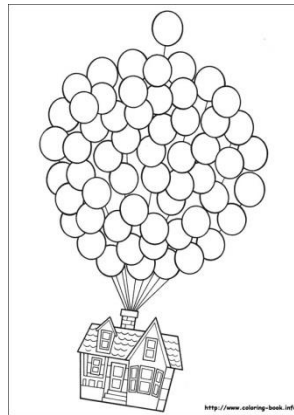


It's time to find a seat and wait for the movie to start. There are no assigned seats, so I may sit wherever I choose!



While I wait for the movie to start I can look over the visual supports that are available that can help me to know what's coming next or help me communicate if I need to take a break or use the bathroom. I can fill out the "First/Then" card and "To Do" checklist with my family or caregiver.

If I need to take a break during the movie there is a sensory break area set up downstairs. There will be a tent set up to relax in as well as some fidget toys and coloring pages to play with. I am not allowed to eat or drink in the theater. There will be a snack table set up in the lobby if I want to eat a snack or have something to drink.
