

WHAT TO WEAR

White on top, black on bottom, closed toe shoes.

Volunteers should arrive wearing clothing and shoes that allow you to move around easily. If assigned to a job which would require walking up and down stairs/inclines or standing for long periods, clothing should allow for you to do so comfortably.

Please wear clothing that is comfortable but appropriate for a theater environment, think “business-casual”. All volunteers should follow the dress code in order to be recognized within the theater and lobby by patrons. Volunteer uniforms help calmly call attention to you and set you apart from the rest of the crowd.

Tips:

 Yes!

- White shirt or sweater with nothing printed on the front, opaque (short or long sleeve!)
- Black pants or mid/long skirt
- Simple, modest jewelry
- White sweater over white shirt
- White shirt with white pinstripes
- Off white/cream colored top
- Optional necktie or scarf in style or color of your choice (no logos or text please!)
- Comfortable closed toe shoes (black shoes are preferred but not required)

- Hats of any kind
- Black sweater over white shirt
- Black and white striped shirt
- Clothing with floral patterns or colorful embroidery
- Clothing with words, phrases, or symbols
- Flip-flops, high heels, or heavy boots
